

**Don Rowing Club of Mississauga  
Private Single Storage Policy  
Effective April 1<sup>st</sup> 2009**

1. Boat storage space is limited and there is a boat storage waiting list.
2. The term of Paid Boat Storage at the Don Rowing Club is April 1 to March 31 each year
3. Individuals storing singles on boat racks must be members in good standing of the Don Rowing Club. This means that all fees and dues owing have been paid in full. We will no longer accept "boat storage only". If your membership registration and appropriate fees (including boat storage fee) are 30 days past due, we will cancel your existing boat rack assignment. The rack will be reassigned to the first person on the waiting list. **Note:** "Paid in full" is defined here as meeting the payment schedule requirements set out in the "**Payment Policy**" section on page 2 of the membership application form. Accessories (oars, car boat racks etc) must be clearly labeled by the owner.
4. Boat storage fees are nonrefundable. The storage period ends March 31<sup>st</sup> of the membership year. The fee will only be prorated when a request for allocation is granted after August 15<sup>th</sup> of the current membership year.
5. It is a requirement that all rowers sign boats out and in on the boat log each time they row. This applies to private equipment as well as club equipment.
6. Boat rack assignments are at the discretion of the Captain and the rack an individual has been allocated may change from time to time. Frequency of use is one factor that may be used in the determination of which rack you will be allocated. The Captain will make efforts to find a solution that is acceptable and workable to all concerned.
7. **The club is not responsible for any loss or damage to the boat or its accessories. Private boats are not covered by the club's insurance.**
8. Rights to Boat Storage racks that remain empty for a period longer than thirty (30) consecutive days will be cancelled unless special written permission has been obtained from the DRC Executive. If cancelled, the member may re-apply for storage.
9. Members who have been notified that their privately-owned oars, single and any other equipment must be removed from the DRC premises have thirty days from the Date of Notification (not the date of receipt) to remove same. Notification will be made by email. **Equipment that has not been removed within the time frame indicated will be moved to an outdoor boat rack or stretcher at the owner's risk.**
10. Equipment that has been left on the premises for a period of twelve months after the stated removal period has expired will be considered abandoned and will be disposed or put into club circulation as per the determination of the DRC Executive. While attempts will be made to notify the owner of such equipment, we cannot notify you if we don't know who you are.
